BECS Testing Status Update

Summary

- Phases 1, 2 and 3 of testing have all been successfully completed
- Two cycles of industry settlement reconciliation testing (phase 3) were completed during April. All Members were able to reconcile their BECS positions for each test day
- For the 2nd cycle, RITS processed 3,500 files (750 FSIs, 1460 advices and 1290 responses)

BECS Migration Plan

Migration Approach

- Settlement for BECS clearing files exchanged on Friday 18 May (except 10.30pm) will occur as per current processes on Monday 21 May
- Submission of FSIs to RITS will commence in conjunction with BECS clearing file exchanges on Monday 21 May
- The first settlements of LVSS transactions will occur in RITS on Tuesday 22 May (BECG from RITS opening and BECN as part of 9am Settlement)

Government File Exchanges

• Government files are sent by only 5 institutions. Other participants are receivers.

Points to Note

- All Friday's activities (apart from 10.30pm exchange) use current processes
- First FSIs are due to be lodged in RITS by around 7am on Monday 21 May

 these represent RBA GDES payments due for settlement on
 Tuesday 22 May
- Friday 10.30pm outward exchange obligations will require use of RITS manual entry functionality. These can be entered on Monday 21 May
- BECS Exchange Summaries and Pending Debit files cease after processing is completed for work of Friday 18 May
- The '9am Batch Amount' shown on the '7.30am Information' screen will not include BECS figures
- Member fallback, if required, is to use RITS manual entry functionality

Production Connectivity Test

- This test must be performed by all Members (or their agent) prior to go-live
- The scope of the test is prove production file transfer connectivity between the Member's and the RBA's file management transfer systems
- Contact the RITS Help Desk to arrange

RITS Production Verification

- Members may optionally choose to send (receive) LVSS messages to (from) RITS Production prior to go-live in a controlled and agreed manner
- Small value trial payments can be sent and settled (as Individual) or recalled
- Member setup arrangements in RITS must be completed by both parties before verification can proceed
- Contact the RITS Help Desk to arrange (if required)

RITS/RBA Arrangements

- Migration support will endeavour to be provided to Members as required, including on the migration weekend
- RITS will open earlier (at 7.00 am) from Monday 21 May for at least 2 weeks. This will provide additional time for transaction management by Members
- Three teleconferences have been scheduled by the RBA

Members should also note that:

- There is an overnight processing window when RITS user access is temporarily unavailable – this will be scheduled well outside BECS activity times. The processing of inbound FSIs is also delayed during this time
- User permissions in RITS need to be (re)set at the start and end of the Overnight Session. At these times, users are logged out and they will be required to login again. Members should ensure that no update activity (e.g. Manual FSI entry) is in progress in the 10 minute period before the Overnight Session commences or ends

RBA LVSS Update

- a) **RITS** Regulations
 - LVSS changes have been in place for around a year
 - Minor update is due for issue shortly
- b) RBA support
 - Once LVSS commences the RITS Help Desk will provide support covering all hours of LVSS activity
 - Normal administration arrangements will continue to apply, including for overnight activities. As now, the RITS Help Desk will act only on a Member's authorised instruction
 - Note that the Member's own RITS Password Administrator is generally the first contact point for user-related issues (passwords, roles, etc)

Industry LVSS Testing - CECS

- Phase 1 Test Cases for all clearing systems were issued by the RBA in November 2011
- Phase 1 testing preparations are underway and are due for completion by 1 June
- APCA has scheduled a workshop on 8 May to discuss CECS industry testing
- As with BECS industry testing, RITS session times can be adjusted by the RBA as necessary for specific testing phases. Two additional multilateral settlement runs have been recently added in RITS Pre-Production to facilitate testing
